## **Salem Sports Program Spectator Policy**

Salem students have many opportunities to participate in organized sports as part of their experience here at Salem Ranch. We encourage the parents of our athletes to come out and cheer on their sons as they compete once their son has reached phase 2. We ask that families take into the account the following guidelines when coming out for sporting events:

- 1. Only immediate family members are to come out for sporting events. Exceptions may be made at the request of the student's parents; provided that request is made in advance through the front office during office hours.
- Families of students that are actively participating in the event are encouraged to attend.
  Students that are not participating may have the opportunity to watch sporting events, but we ask that families of nonv participants not come out for events unless specifically invited by Salem Ranch.
- 3. While it may sometimes be possible for families to take their athlete out immediately after a sporting event, we do ask that all offver campus activity be cleared in advance through the front office during office hours.
- 4. As with any other occasion, all visitors on campus are expected to park out front in the visitor parking and sign in at the main building before going anywhere else on campus. This is a universal policy that applies in every situation. It is important that we have a record of all visitors to campus.
- Spectators are expected to realize the positive experience that sports participation can provide.
  They will be expected to help provide a positive and encouraging atmosphere for all participants in the sporting event.

Salem is very pleased to be able to offer the opportunities for organized sports to all our students. We are encouraged when families take advantage of the opportunity to share this positive experience with their son. Thank you for doing your part to make these events a valuable part of life at Salem.
